Colony Assessment.

General Assessment - Apply to every colony.

- 1. Is queen Present and Laying?
- 2. Has colony enough Room till next inspection?
- 3. Has colony enough Stores till next inspection?
- 4. Is the colony Developing as well as others?
- 5. Any signs of Disease or abnormality?
- 6. Any queen cells?

Selection for Breeding.

In addition to above consider the following **behavioural traits:**

- A = Docility. (Non-stinging, non-following, non-jumping.)
- B = Steadiness on the comb. (Absence of running.)
- C = Brood Pattern. (Compactness of brood; absence of empty cells.)
- D = Pollen storage. (Pollen packed over, around and under the brood nest.)
- E = Comb Building. (Speed in occupying supers, drawing foundation, honey storage and quality of comb capping.)

Our Colony Assessment Card covers all eleven criteria.
